
## The Summer In Review!

Of those kids, Jubilee got to help 16 kids come to camp. Six of those kids live in our trailer park. The rest were kids whose families are involved with Jubilee through other avenues. Ten kids, total, made decisions to receive Christ as their Savior during camp. Four of those were Jubilee kids. Praise God for how He works!



# KidzKamp Continued ...

One of the highlights of this year's KidzKamp was the Refugee Simulation Missions Activity. Inspired by the ministry of Vision Beyond Borders to the Karen tribe in Burma, this activity helped the kids to experience some of what it is like to be part of a tribe targeted with genocide. Chapel was interrupted by a "fireman" announcing that their village had been bombed. Kids then gathered into cabin groups and fled to the "Thai border" to a "Refugee Camp." Along the way, they had to contend with "injuries," search for "food," beware of "poisonous snakes," and avoid "Burmese Soldiers" (Middle Schoolers with squirt guns and toy hand cuffs). Once at the camp, they had to build "shelters" without sufficient supplies.

The activity was a profound lesson and the kids had a great time doing it. Carolyn was the one who planned and pulled this whole thing together. Awesome job, Honey!!
