The Genesis Process Addiction Counseling Training



God is really, really faithful! Where there is a true need, He provides! Addictions are very common in many of the families we know through Jubilee. Our desire is to help people gain victory over the things that hold them back, but truthfully, my seminary training was not aimed at meeting these kinds of needs.

But, God provided! Michael Dye, the writer and developer of the Genesis Process for relapse prevention came to the smallest town he had ever spoken at – Cody, Wyoming!

The Genesis Process training is a 40 hour, week-long training seminar that equips people to put others through an addiction counseling program that has been proven to be very effective. It is being used in many rescue mission ministries and is being translated into numerous languages across the world. The program is both scientifically and scripturally based. The most amazing information related to the limbic system in the brain and it's striking resemblance to what the Bible calls the "heart."

Jubilee was able to put four people through this training - Carolyn, Wayne McBroom, Hollie Guerrero, and myself (Brian). We are by no means experts yet, but we are equipped as we begin working with people in one-on-one and group contexts to help them find freedom over their addictions. 🌈


